

Memorandum For Record

All Members Palm Creek Pickleball Club

Palm Creek Golf and RV Resort (Sun Communities) has promulgated a policy dealing with use of Resort facilities. Portions of the information contained in this Memorandum for Record is restated from the afore mentioned policy.

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Definitions: The following definitions are extracted from the Palm Creek Golf and RV Resort Guest Guide under Rules and Regulations. Website is located at:

Resident - refers to those renting a site for 181 days or more in a calendar year.

Guest - refers to those persons renting a site for less than 181 days in a calendar year.

Visitor - is anyone invited into the Resort by a Resident or Guest on a daily or overnight basis.

The following information is extracted from the Welcome to Palm Creek brochure under FAQ's.

Name Badges - Who needs a name badge? Badges must be worn by employees, residents, guests and visitors at all times in the resort.

The following information is also extracted from the Welcome to Palm Creek brochure under Guideline Basics.

Wear of Name Badges - In order to participate in activities or use the facilities, everyone must obtain and wear their photo ID badges. Badges are issued in Guest Services ....

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General Guidelines as issued by the Ranger staff.

An observation by any Resident or Guest (see above definitions) of an apparently unauthorized person utilizing park facilities should be reported to one of the Park Rangers. To summon a Park Ranger simply call the Front Gate House @ 520-371-5860 or Guest Services @ 520-421-7000. Upon arrival at your location, point out to the Park Ranger the unauthorized person who is utilizing the Resort facilities. The park ranger will handle the situation from that point.

Supplemental guidance to all Palm Creek Pickleball Club Members.

As a matter of personal safety and welfare, all club members are instructed in the mandatory wear of their Palm Creek Golf and RV Resort issued photo ID badge. Not only is this policy in accordance with the Resort rules and regulations, there is no other readily available method to identify an unresponsive injured player. Your safety and your wellbeing are paramount to the club.

Once a person is identified as an apparent unauthorized facility user, club members will not, under any circumstances, engage that person either verbally or physically. Observe, identify and report. The enforcement of Resort rules and regulations is a matter handled by Resort Management, their authorized representatives and civil law enforcement.

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
